- Tractor Operator: field prep, cultivation, planting, seeding.
- Manage Field Crew, irrigation systems, harvest, etc.
- Organic pest management.
- Record-keeping, planning, preparing, coordinating with other managers.

Work Experience/Skills Desired:

Minimum 1 year experience on a vegetable farm and minimum 3 years experience as a tractor operator with farming implements. Experience in related field preferred (farming, outdoor work, military, grocery, restaurant, etc.) Strong interest in organic/biodynamic vegetables, ability to pace oneself and stay motivated, good communication and respect for others, and flexibility for changing tasks. Must be able to work long hours in all kinds of weather and be able to lift 50lb+. Must be able to commit to the full season thru November. Clean driving record. Bilingual a plus.
