

## **Planting Guide for Aspen Moon Farm Organic Raspberries**

Plant 12-18" apart in the garden. Best planted in a "hedgerow", as plants will spread and fill in the row creating a hedgerow. Plant in full sun. Keep soil moist until roots have established, then water intermittently allowing soil to dry between waterings. Be sure to winter water during the first winter, as roots are not deep enough to tolerate the dry period. Plants will bear fruit in 1-2 years. Fall bearing primocane types usually fruit August until the first hard frost. Follow primocane pruning instructions for best fruit production.
